

Food Pantry: Offered weekly at our location. Each individual and or family can get food that will help them to make ends meet as prices of food and other items continue to soar. Every Wednesday, each household will typically receive a meat, vegetables, fruits, produce box, bread, cereal, and desserts per availability. (Serving Times: 9am to 11am on Wednesdays)

Clothes Closet: Offered weekly on both Tuesdays and Wednesdays at our location. Each individual and or family can shop for clothing one time per week based on their needs. We typically have clothing for all ages groups and sexes but seems to have a shortage at most times in the men's clothing section. (Serving Times: 9am to 11am, Tuesdays & Wednesdays)
